TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR RANDOM DRAW REGISTRATIONS



TO ENTER THE DRAWS

- You must be a Québec resident and hold a valid hunter's certificate.
- You must complete an official entry form or enter online at www.sepaq.com/randomdraw.
- You must enter your hunter's certificate number (**8 embossed characters**), last name, first name, and date of birth **as they appear on the certificate**. The failure of this validation with the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune will result in the rejection of the draw registration. If there is an error on your certificate, or if you believe that it may have expired (expiry date before 03-31-1994), we invite you to contact your regional office or the Service de la réglementation, de la tarification et des permis at **418 521-3895** to make the necessary corrections.
- The substitute's name and hunter's certificate number must be written on your registration form. In no case may the substitute's name be changed after the draw has taken place.
- Only one registration per entry code will be accepted. **If you win more than once in the same draw, the computer will assign you a territory.** The entry form numbers determine your preferences. The lowest number, if selected, will be your first choice. For online entries, please refer to the instructions on the www.sepaq.com/randomdraw Web site.
- All of the boxes on your form must be completed, or the form will be rejected without notice before the draw, and no refunds will be granted.
- Entrants **must** complete boxes 180 to 185 of the entry form, since the code determines the choice of territory.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENT

- **The \$8 per entry registration fee** (taxes included) is non-refundable. Payment in the form of a money order or cheque made out to Sépaq must accompany your registration.
- You may include several entries with a single payment in the same envelope. However, be sure to indicate the registration form number on the back of the money order or cheque.
- Any money order or cheque that contains an error or is refused by a financial institution will automatically be rejected from the draw, along with the winner's rights.
- No post-dated cheques are accepted.
- In the event of an administrative error in processing your entry or during the random draw, your sole recourse as an entrant will consist of the refund of your registration fee. We recommend that you keep copies of your payment vouchers as well as your form numbers.
- Sépaq must receive your entries no later than January 31, 2012 at the Sales & Reservations Office address indicated on the back of the entry form. The draw will be held mid-February.

WILDLIFE RESERVES: SUBSTITUTION RULES

WARNING! A GROUP LEADER OR SUBSTITUTE IS ONLY ENTITLED ONE MOOSE HUNTING OR WHITE-TAILED DEER HUNTING TRIP IN THE WILDLIFE RESERVE NETWORK.

Substitutions are authorized only under the following conditions:

- A death in the group leader's immediate family;
- Convocation of the group leader to a court of law;
- An unforeseen medical reason for the group leader.

Official supporting documents (subpoena with report, the original of a doctor's note, etc.) are required for all substitutions (in the name entered on the registration form only), and must accompany the substitution request at least **five working days** before the beginning of the stay. Sépaq reserves the right to check the validity of the documents before the Sales and Reservations Office approves the substitution request. At its discretion, Sépaq may also require additional documents to be provided by a specific date. File modification fees of \$52 apply. If the deadline of five working days is not respected, or the transfer to the substitute is refused, the reservation could be cancelled without a refund. If both the group leader and the substitute are unable to attend, the reservation could be cancelled without a refund. No work or school-related reasons will be authorized by the Sépaq Sales and Reservations Office.

In all cases, the substitute's hunter's certificate number will be verified. If the number cannot be verified, the reservation will be cancelled.

For moose hunting, the winning group leader must identify himself upon arrival at the wildlife reserve by presenting an official identification card with a photograph and must accompany the group when an animal is bagged.



MOOSE HUNTING IN WILDLIFE RESERVES

In 2011, moose hunting results for the wildlife reserves place the overall success rate at 65.6%. In 2012, approximately 2216 groups will be attributed a moose hunting trip in a secure sector. Generally, the limit is one animal per group of two to four hunters.

NEW REGULATIONS

This year, Sépaq is offering two new regulations to support the next generation of hunters and encourage small groups to hunt moose in the wildlife reserves.

- A single group of hunters may now have a minimum of 2 hunters, so a double group can have a minimum of 4 hunters.
- A young person, meaning a person between the ages of 12 and 17, or a student from 18 to 24 years of age who carries a valid student card, can join a group of 2 to 4 hunters free of charge as part of a moose hunting package. A double group can host 2 young people.



NEW PRODUCTS

- Réserve faunique de Portneuf now offers a camping package. We have room for twelve groups of hunters.
- Single group stays of 5 or 6 days are now available at Réserve faunique de Rimouski, along with a 5-day package for double groups.
- The conservation hunt of recent years at Réserve faunique de Matane was effective in regulating herds. Consequently, a new type of double group package allows the harvest of two animals of your choice. However, the double group hunting package, for which it is mandatory to harvest at least one antlerless moose out of the two, will retain the name *Conservation Double Group* package. Along the same lines, Triple Harvest packages are now only available under the American plan, with a total of 17 packages to be assigned. Thirty lucky hunters will also get to enjoy a new black powder hunting package for single groups. Last but not least, the popular single group package with rustic shelter accommodations is back, with 30 spots available.

To participate, one hunter must be between 12 and 17 years of age and hold a hunter's certificate.

WHITE-TAILED DEER HUNTING IN WILDLIFE RESERVES

Groups must be composed of at least 4 hunters and a maximum of 6 hunters, except in Réserve faunique Rouge-Matawin, where double groups must consist of 8 to 12 hunters. The bag limit is one animal per hunter. With the exception of group hunts, once a hunter bags a white-tailed deer, his permit is no longer valid.

Depending on the condition of the herd in the spring, a special antlerless deer permit may be offered for some wildlife reserves in a random draw. Consult the *Special Hunting Permit* brochure available in May 2012.

Note : At Réserve faunique de Papineau-Labelle, groups made up of one child from 12 to 17 years old are invited to contact the reserve before September 5 to find out if they could get an antlerless deer hunting permit, depending on how many of these permits are issued by the government.

• Rustic Shelter Accommodations

The 4.8 m X 7.3 m (16' X 24') shelters have wooden walls and roofs for greater comfort. They are set along rivers in the Natiscotec Sector and are fully equipped with amenities such as woodstoves, solar lighting, stove, refrigerator, small sinks and pit toilets. A rack is available with paper and boxes for transporting game.

• Cabin Accommodations

Cabins are fully equipped with running water, bathroom, stove, refrigerator and cookware. The cabins at Tête-de-Jupiter are solar powered, while the cabins at Rivière à l'Huile and l'Anse Castor are powered by propane. A rack is available with paper and boxes for transporting game.

• Services

A territory warden ensures that equipment operates properly and that territorial limits are respected. The warden is also responsible for registering bagged animals.

• European Plan Packages Include:

- Five nights with four days of hunting;
- One pick-up truck per group (gas not included);
- Bag limit of two white-tailed deer per hunter.

• Not Included in the Package:

- Meals;
- Air transportation to the island, but Sépaq Anticosti offers flights from Mont-Joli, Québec City or Montréal depending on availability;
- Hunting licences.

WILDLIFE RESERVES - GENERAL POINTS

The draw will take place in **mid-February**. We will advise participants of the results of the draw by e-mail or mail, depending on the registration method that was used. For moose hunting and white-tailed deer stays, Sépaq staff members will contact all wildlife reserve winners in the sequential order determined during the draw so that they can choose their stay dates and sectors. Hunters must rent the type of accommodation that corresponds to their winning registration.



TELEPHONE RESERVATIONS

Until March 28, 2012, cancellations will be filled from the waiting list for each registration code. Replacements will be designated by the Sales and Reservations Office or staff at the particular wildlife reserve.

On March 19, 2012, starting at 9 a.m., all non-winning participants of the random draw for moose hunting and white-tailed deer hunting in the wildlife reserves will have reservation priority over those who did not participate in these draws. This priority lasts for one day. Only the Sales and Reservations Office (**1 800 665-6527**) ensures this service.

Starting on **March 20, 2012**, at 9 a.m., we will accept all reservation quests by phone without considering the random draws.



WORK UNDERWAY DURING HUNTING SEASON AND ABORIGINAL HUNTING AND FISHING ACTIVITIES

Logging, transportation of logs or other commercial operations, including trapping, may be underway during your stay at any of the wildlife reserves. Aboriginals hunt and fish in many wildlife reserves, including the following: Ashuapmushuan, Laurentides, La Vérendrye, Papineau-Labelle and Port-Cartier-Sept-Îles. There will be no refunds or compensation should any of these activities be taking place.
