



RANDOM DRAW – WINTER CARIBOU HUNTING



Terms and conditions

Despite their relative abundance, the number of caribou in the hunting area can vary greatly from year to year, since they are migratory animals. Hunting in Zone 22 is in an area near the LG2 and LG3 reservoirs.

- There will be 250 winners for the 2011 random draw.*
- Each winner will be awarded two permits which give the right to bag two caribou.
- The hunter holding the second permit may only hunt if the winner of the draw is in zone 22A.
- For the 2011-2012 hunting periods (fall and winter), a hunter will not be able to hold more than one permit and will hunt only in the zone or area designated on the permit.*
- The hunting period will extend from November 15, 2011 to January 15, 2012.*
- Harvesting antlerless caribou will be prohibited.*

* At the time this publication was released, these new rules were subject to adoption.

A student aged 18 to 24 years old, who is the child of the winner or his spouse, may use the winner's caribou hunting permit. This student must carry the permit, a valid hunters' certificate and a student card.

The Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune is responsible for regulations and granting caribou hunting licences.

To enter the draw

- You must be a Québec resident and hold a valid hunter's certificate.
- Only one registration is accepted.
- On the e-form, check off the registration code and click on *Submit* to complete your registration.
- You must enter your hunter's certificate number (**8 embossed characters**), last name, first name, and birth date as indicated on your hunter's certificate.
- If you see the message «your hunter's certificate validation has failed», please start again and make sure to enter the information **as indicated on your hunter's certificate**. If the same message appears, please contact the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune at **418 521-3895** from Monday to Friday between 8:30 AM and noon and between 1 PM and 4:30 PM to verify the information about your hunter's certificate.
- If you pass the hunter's certificate validations, you must then enter all of your contact information and click on *Submit* in order to complete your registration and make your payment.

How to make your payment

- **The \$8 per entry registration fee** (including taxes) is non-refundable. On the Sépaq Web site, the payment must be made by credit card. You must enter both your credit card number and the expiry date. The draw registration is only complete after the credit card institution issues a confirmation of payment.
- In case of an error in the administrative processing of a registration or during the random draw, your sole recourse as a participant will be the refund of your registration fees.
- We recommend that you to keep your form number.
- Sépaq must receive your entries by mail no later than April 30, 2011 at the Sales & Reservations Office address indicated on the back of the entry form. The draw will be held mid-May.

Correction service

Complete each section of the form carefully and accurately. However, if you inadvertently make a mistake on your entry form, we will advise you by mail on how to correct your entry, time permitting. If you receive a notice, phone us immediately at **1 900 565-7333***.

Assignment of regulated caribou hunting permits

The computer selects the winners of caribou hunting permits. The Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune will send permit application forms to winners. Other draw entrants will be notified that they were not selected. Cancellations will be filled from the waiting list. Hunting permits are not transferable.

Contest

All valid entries received by **April 4, 2011** will be eligible for the draw of a **\$500 GIFT CERTIFICATE** redeemable at any Sépaq establishment.

Important notes

- The Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune, which administer these hunting activities, reserve the right to limit, alter, or cancel certain services and activities if circumstances warrant.
- Sépaq conducts the random draws for, and with the authorization of the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune.
- Sépaq draws are supervised by an independent accounting firm.
- Sépaq wishes to remind all entrants that completing or signing a draw entry form on behalf of another person or using another person's name with the intention of committing fraud and without legitimate authorization may constitute a criminal act.
- When you enter this draw, you agree that Sépaq may suspend your right to participate in random draws for two years if the permits were obtained by an impersonation, or if you are accused or condemned of an infraction related to a fraud or the illegal use of a hunter's certificate in the context of a random draw.
- The rates given do include the taxes.
