

Random Draw Private Vacation Lots on Public Lands

Terms and conditions

- By registering you accept this sentence: I authorize the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forest to contact me to participate in surveys or user tests in connection with public land.
- First, find out how it works and what land is available by looking at:
 - 1. The official brochure of the draw
 - 2. The <u>Quebec.ca website</u>
 - 3. The interactive map of the lands
- On the random draws home page, select the draw you would like to register for.
- Check off the desired registration code(s) on the electronic form and click on *Continue*.
- Only one registration is accepted per registration code.
- You can register for several different codes but **note that you pay for each registration code**.
- Once your payment is approved by the financial institution, the transaction ends with a confirmation notice showing the registration form(s) number(s). We recommend that you to keep your form number(s).
- You must be 18 or older on September 20, 2023.
- Please take the time to validate your registration before paying. If you realize you have made a mistake, write a precise email to <u>tirageausort@sepaq.com</u>.
- The \$34.49 fee per registration code (including taxes) is non-refundable. On the Sépaq Web site, the payment must be made by credit card. You must enter both your credit card number and the expiry date. The draw registration is only complete after the credit card institution issues a confirmation of payment.
- In case of an error in the administrative processing of a registration or during the random draw, your sole recourse as a participant will be the refund of your registration fees.
- We recommend that you to keep your form number(s).
- Your registrations must be completed by October 29, 2023.
