
Efficient Logistics... For a Hassle-Free Stay

The Island's airport facilities can accommodate large aircraft thanks to a 1.489 m (4.886 foot) runway for instrument flight. There is also a parking area reserved for private planes. Otherwise, customers arrive on regular or chartered flights from Sept-Îles and Mont-Joli, with connecting commercial flights from Montréal and Québec City. The lodge is located on an exceptional site 12 miles from the mouth of the Jupiter River, thus its name. Twelve guests occupy six double rooms. Four complete bathrooms and a large cloakroom with a drying rack add to your comfort. The meals are served in the private dining room reserved exclusively for lodge guests. At the end of the day, you can go swap stories at the bar and lounge, complete with a fireplace and comfortable armchairs. The lounge is also equipped with satellite television and a card table.

A Stay

The Jupiter River shimmers along a 50 km route still marked by mileposts, like in the old days. Only eight anglers fish in some thirty fishing pools. A rotation takes place in four sectors, two upstream and two downstream of the lodge. One guide ensures the exceptional quality of the experience for two anglers.

When water levels are high enough, salmon fishing fans can enjoy fishing from canoes.

Lunch camps on the banks of the river provide shelter for savouring a hot or cold meal. However, some customers prefer to return to the lodge for a short break before the evening fishing trip.




Jupiter XII is also white-tailed deer hunting paradise. This fabulous package combines the pleasures of fishing and hunting.

The guides have excellent knowledge of hunting and the territory, which translates into an enviable success rate. As they do for the salmon, they are happy to prepare your catches for storage and transport.












A DISTINCTIVE LOCATION
