This letter is in response to your request for document access received on April 16, 2018 and by which you would like to obtain from the Société des établissements de plein air du Québec (Sépaq) :

*«...copies of all communications, including but not limited to letters, memoranda, documents, and emails, between the direction and employees of the Sentier International des Appalaches-Quebec and the direction and employees of the Parc de la Gaspésie, during the period of January 1, 2017 and March 31, 2018. »*

Please find enclosed the emails exchanged between the direction and employees of the Parc de la Gaspésie and employees of the Sentier International des Appalaches-Quebec, during the period of January 1, 2017 and March 31, 2018.

However, we did delete the information to which access is not authorized as provided in sections 9, 14, 23, 24, 37, 53, 54 and 56 of the Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information.

Considering that your request for document access has been processed in accordance with the provisions of the Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the protection of personal information protection, we would like to remind you that you may request a review of this decision to the Commission d'accès à l'information. The application must be made within thirty days of the date of this decision, in conformity with sections 135 and following of the aforementioned Act. To this end, a notice of recourse is attached to this letter.
