*Please don't come before 5 p.m.*

### RULES

- Do not feed the animals. To avoid attracting animals, never leave your food waste or leftovers unattended.
- Keep to the paths, foot traffic damages the groundcover. Don't venture outside authorized areas.
- To maintain our peace and quiet, a curfew is in effect from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. Avoid making noise at all times. Use headphones for your music.
- Up to 2 vehicles can be parked per space if space permits.
- Campfires or cooking fires are allowed where fire pits have been provided. However, these fires must be watched at all times. Make sure you fully put out your fire before leaving or going to bed. To prevent pests, please do not bring wood from outside of the park and do not take wood out of the park. Collecting dead or any other type of wood within the park is prohibited. During opening hours, it is possible to buy wood at the centre de services de la Rivière-du-sud-Ouest and at the Centre de découverte et de services Ferme Rioux.
- No pets allowed in the accommodations, except for guide dogs.
- You must pay your entry fees and carry the receipt with you at all times. You can pay online, at any time, at the following link: [sepaq.com/accesparcs](http://sepaq.com/accesparcs)

### YOUR DEPARTURE

- If possible, please send a text message with the name of your accommodation to 418-896-3117, to let us know you have left.
- **Site condition:** we ask that you please leave sites in the condition in which you found them. In other words, leave everything clean and tidy.
- **Dishes:** it is important to wash, dry and put away your dishes.
- **Waste materials:** dispose of your garbage and recycling at the nearest washroom facility.  
*Offenders may be charged additional cleaning fees.*



### 5 ground rules to follow in nature

#### Our national parks

get millions of visits each year. Harmful behaviors can cause permanent damage to the environment and hinder other visitors' experience. Let's do our part to protect nature so we can all enjoy it for years to come.

- Stay on trails and in designated visitor areas**  
Don't step off the trails or walk in the undergrowth to avoid trampling plants and compacting the soil.
- Do not gather dead wood**  
Help preserve the undergrowth by leaving dead wood in place. It serves as shelter for wildlife and enriches the soil after decomposing.
- Do not feed wildlife**  
Allow animals to feed themselves so they can follow their natural instincts. Keep all foods out of their reach.
- Keep your distance when observing animals**  
Repeated disturbances can alter their behavior and affect their ability to find food, mate, and communicate with each other.
- Be mindful of the peace and quiet and adhere to curfews**  
Noise frightens wildlife, and people visit national parks to enjoy nature. Please follow curfews and refrain from making noise at all times.

## ÎLE-AUX-AMOURS SECTOR

Accessible on foot. Trolley available in the parking lot.

**Potable water:** one 18-litre container of drinking water is included per night.

**Shower:** The showers are located in the Rivière-du-Sud-Ouest campsite washroom facility.

## TOMBOLO SECTOR

**Potable water:** a drinking-water access point is located near your lodging.

**Shower:** The showers are located in the Tombolo campsite washroom facility.


## FOR YOUR COMFORT

**Ventilation:** it is important to open the dome (maximum 1") and the door window during meal preparation. This limits condensation buildup. There is a crank next to the door to operate the dome's latch hook (to open, turn counterclockwise).

**Wood stove:** Wood is provided for the Yurt stove. This is located in the wood box outside.

**Other equipment:** the instructions for using your yurt's equipment are located onsite in the welcome manual.

## FOR YOUR COMFORT

**Equipment:** the instructions for using your cabin's equipment are located onsite in the welcome manual.

**Wood stove:** eco logs are provided for the fireplace (2 per night). These can be found in the wood box outside.



## SPEED LIMIT

To ensure the safety of all visitors, remember that the speed limit is 10 km/h on the campgrounds and near the service areas.
