## BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME... TWO VERY IMPORTANT POINTS TO CHECK

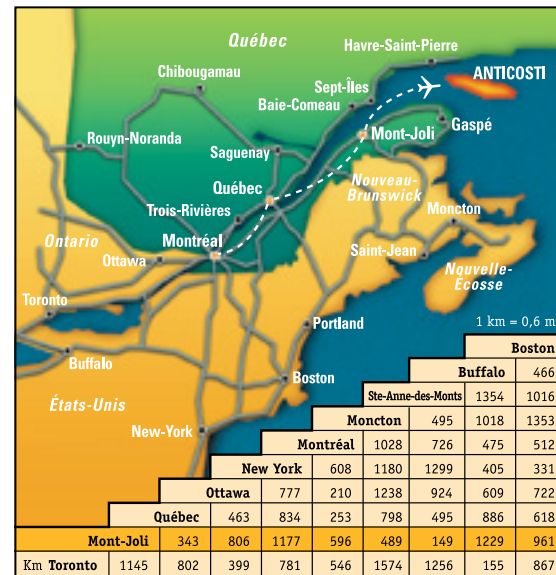
### Cancellation of a stay

No refunds will be granted, but we accept replacements at any time. Sépaq Anticosti is not responsible for major causes (sickness, flight delays, disasters, death of a close relative), **including flight delays caused by poor weather** or other conditions beyond its control.

**Sépaq Anticosti therefore strongly recommends that you purchase cancellation insurance before your stay begins.**

### If your package includes a vehicle, you need insurance

Check with your insurance broker to find out if you have **QEF n°. 27**, covering a vehicle valued at \$45,000. Each driver must provide a photocopy of this proof of insurance. To prevent flat tires, respect the speed limit and do not drive on the shoulders of the road. There is no charge for a normal flat. For a repairable split on the side of the tire, you must pay \$150, and if the tire cannot be repaired, \$300 will be charged.



## PRACTICAL TIPS FOR THE PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF OUR HERITAGE

During your stay on Anticosti Island, we ask you to show the same respect for the environment as you do for your friends. We would be very grateful. We believe that this milieu preserves something of great value. We respect it and we are happy that you can enjoy it.

**ANIMALS** So that visitors can freely admire the white-tailed deer from up close, a municipal regulation prohibits dogs on the island. Thank you for your understanding.

### IN NATURE, MY SAFETY IS MY RESPONSIBILITY

Outdoor activities may involve certain risks. You must ensure that you have the skills and abilities required to undertake the chosen activity. It is important to know the risks inherent to this activity, respect your abilities, and have the appropriate equipment. Moreover, while not representing a considerable danger, activities undertaken in an isolated natural environment clearly present greater risks on Anticosti Island due its distance from health services.

## PLAN YOUR FLIGHT

### Air transportation: Departure times

**Montréal: 7 a.m. Québec City: 8:25 a.m.**

Arrive at the airport an hour and a half before departure time. Departure from Mont-Joli: An agent will contact you one week before the departure to confirm your flight time. Your return time will be confirmed when you register at the Port-Menier reception office.

## If you are not travelling with us...

You reserved your flight with a company other than Sépaq Anticosti; it is very important to let us know what time you will be arriving so that we can meet you at the Port-Menier airport.

## YOUR ARRIVAL AT PORT-MENIER

### At the Port-Menier Airport

A member of our team will be there to greet you. To speed up the vehicle rental process, make sure to have all of the necessary documents on hand: driver's licence, copy of your insurance, including endorsement **QEF n°. 27** (details on page 4). The onsite staff will explain Anticosti's particular road conditions and the use of radio communication. Then, head directly to the Sépaq Anticosti office in the town of Port-Menier, about five minutes away.

### At the Sépaq Anticosti Reception Office

It is mandatory for all visitors to register at our reception office in the village to ensure safe travel throughout the Sépaq Anticosti territory. You must fill out the stay forms for each member of your group. This is also the time to buy your fishing licences if you want to go fishing while here.

## PARC NATIONAL D'ANTICOSTI THE JEWEL OF A MYSTERIOUS ISLAND!

Parc national d'Anticosti has an area of 572 km<sup>2</sup>. It was created by the Québec government in 2001. This park groups together all of the elements of the natural region called Anticosti Island, and magnificent components of Québec and Canada. A jewel of Québec's natural heritage, this park's breathtaking scenery, easily observable wildlife, and unique plant life will charm everyone who partakes of its spectacles and mysterious circuits. A network of short, medium and long hiking trails wind through the park, offering over 45 km of enchantment.



### DAY FISHING

**On a lake or river: starting at \$18.58 / pers. / day\***

**Motor rental (2.5 hp): \$36 / day**

**Bait available in Port-Menier: CCIA and Accommodeur Malouin**

You can book 24 hours ahead by radioing the McDonald Visitors Centre. Complementary activity subject to quotas and dependent on weather conditions; it must therefore not be considered the main objective of your stay.

## PACKAGE

### Trout and salmon fishing package on Rivière à la Loutre...

You will have access to rivière à la Loutre, the perfect spot for trying your hand at fly fishing. You can also fish for trout in Petit lac Long and Grand lac Long. For salmon and sea trout fishing, you must purchase the provincial licences, available at our reception office in Port-Menier.

#### Catch limit

- TROUT: 10/day and a total of 20 in your possession at all times.
- SALMON: 1 small salmon /day. Catch limit, 7. Large salmon must be released. 3 catch and release per day

#### Equipment the most used

- Rods, 2.4 metres (8 feet) or 2.7 metres (9 feet) with reel, floating line n<sup>os</sup> 7-8.
- Single hook flies: Rusty Rat, Silver Rat, Silver Cossaboom, Pattern Fly, Black Ghost, Mickey Finn, Bomber and Green Machine.

### Plan Your Fishing Trip

Without being miraculous, the fishing will be good... at the very least, the gorgeous natural settings will fill you with awe. Fishing takes place in a sector that is exclusive to your group. We provide life jackets, row boats and motors. Here are some suggestions for fishing equipment to bring.

## PRACTICAL TIPS FOR YOUR VACATION

### Services in Port-Menier

Before heading to your place of accommodations, you can stop in at one of the Port Menier stores to make your purchases and a good meal:

**Auberge Port-Menier:** Restaurant, accommodations, boutique and Espace découverte.

**Reception Office:** Reception Office and boutique.

**Boutique des Artisans:** Écomusée, CRMI (gas station), Caisse Populaire, Accommodeur Malouin (convenience store).

**CCIA Grocery:** The Port-Menier grocery store-butcher shop offers a surprising variety of foods: fruits, vegetables, cheeses, meats, breads, pastries, etc. For a small deposit, the store will lend you a cooler to transport your purchases. CCIA grocery store is also a SAQ dealer.

### Auberge McDonald

To add a gourmet flavour to your stay when you arrive on the island, check the business hours of the Auberge McDonald restaurant BYOB (bring your own wine). Simply book a few hours ahead by radio communication. Parc national d'Anticosti's boutique store is in McDonald.

#### DID YOU KNOW THAT...

Lobster season takes place from June to mid-July on Anticosti Island.

### GAS STATIONS

**McDonald Visitors Centre:** open from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

**Chicotte-la-Mer Visitors Centre:** open from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

**Town of Port-Menier:** open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## TRAVELLING ON THE ISLAND

**On the day of your arrival, after signing in, go straight to your place of accommodations. Take advantage of the daylight to travel, as the distances are sometimes long. Be careful on the roads, wildlife is abundant.**

**You'll probably find the island to be much bigger than you imagined. To appreciate you stay and to enjoy the beauty and riches of Anticosti nature, make your way to the McDonald or Port-Menier Visitors Centres to better plan your activities and save time when you travel on the island. Don't worry, it's impossible to see everything on your first visit.**

## CHECK-LIST What to Bring to Anticosti

With Anticosti's sub-boreal climate, the sunny days are very hot but the nights are quite cool, perfect for sleeping. Average temperatures range from 10 °C to 25 °C.

For your comfort, plan on bringing warm clothing.

The island is ideal for picnics, more elaborate suppers, or snacks around a fireplace.
