Cross-country skiers

- Ski along marked trails and in the specified direction.
- Clear the trail if you stop or fall, so as not to be an obstacle to other skiers.
- Along a double trail, slower skiers must remain in the right track, thereby clearing the left track for faster skiers.
- Snowshoes and pedestrians are NOT allowed on cross-country ski trails.

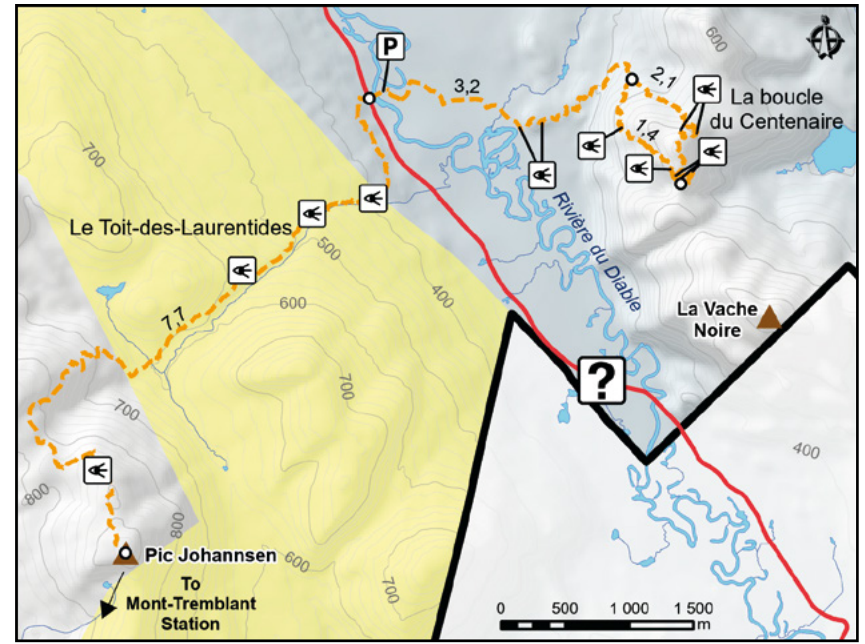

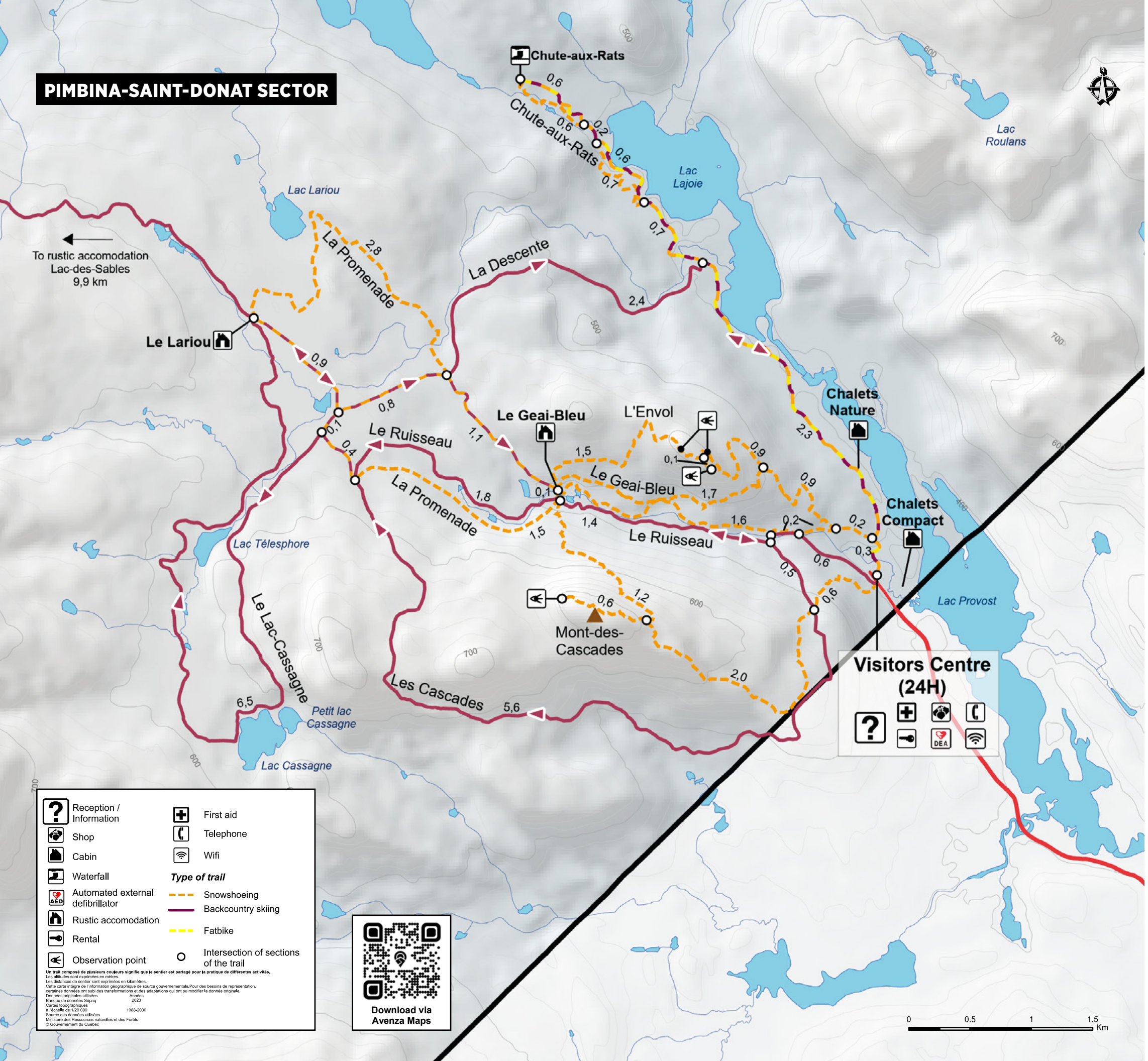
