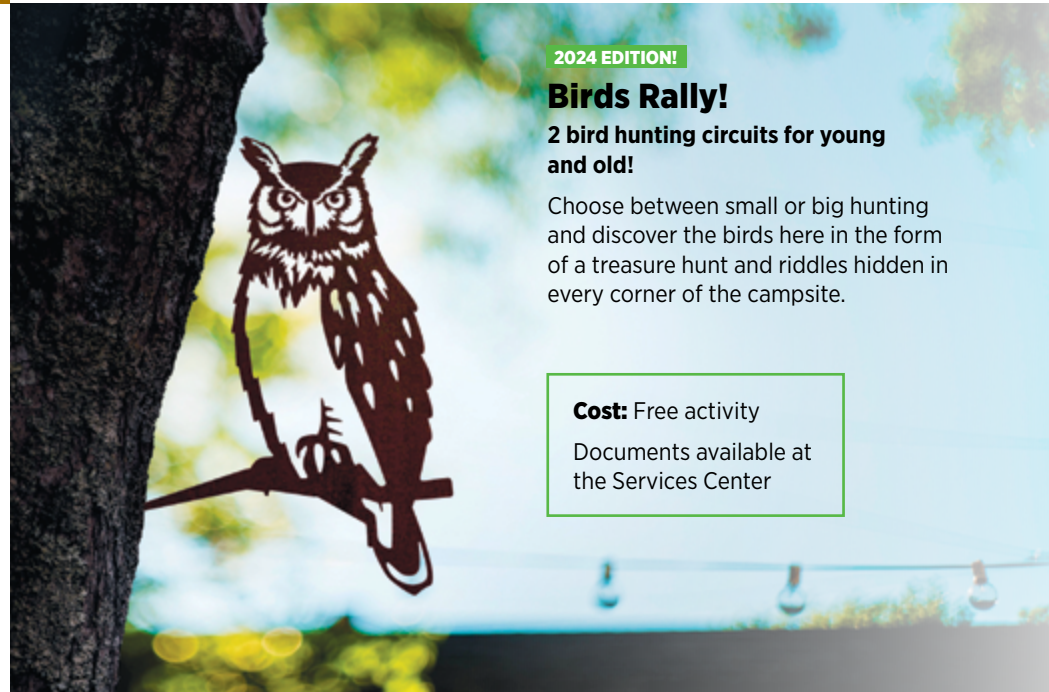

Did you Know That?

Did you know that the wood you burn could be a ticking time bomb for the campground's forest and the whole region?

Transporting firewood is an important vector of tree diseases. Some harmful and newly established insects (like the emerald ash borer) or those that are making their way here (like the Asian long-horned beetle) represent significant risks to our forests.

To reduce these risks, please leave your firewood at home and get your wood directly from the campground.

Swimming Pool

The Rivia Promenade

This magnificent multifunctional walk that runs along the campsite and the river remains a must during your stay! 4.5 km long, it now extends beyond the Domaine Trent. Access from the campsite is open from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Do you want a festive atmosphere close to the campsite with the added bonus of a view of the river? On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings, starting at 5 p.m., sip a drink to the sound of guest musicians. Nothing better to start the evening!

A Greener Campsite

As part of Sépaq's sustainable development actions, several initiatives have been implemented at the campsite such as:

- The installation of **four electric car charging stations**
- The suspension of the sale of beverages in **plastic bottles**
- The addition of a **self-service water trough**
- Participation in a **composting** pilot project
- **Removal of propane stoves** from ready-to-camp sites
- Use of a **hybrid car** by the administration
- The use of **power tools** by our team maintenance, all with the aim of reducing GHG production and offering you an increasingly green campsite

Since 2023, we have been collaborating with Récupex, a circular economy company that recovers and transforms our old ready-to-camp canvases into reusable wood transport bags.
